### MINUTES

- I. **Welcome - President Dave Froelich** welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- II. **Prayer – Tom Rettig** led us in prayer.
- III. **Roll Call – Bob Von Kaenel** called roll. Absent were – Wayne Wiseman, Dan Schwieterman, Dave Kleman, Rich Venuto and Pat Carroll
- IV. **Treasurer’s Report – Wayne Wiseman** – none given due to Wayne’s absence.
- V. **Presentation –**
  - A. Carol Helmick – American Cancer Society – Cancer vs. Coaches  
It was decided to wait until the October meeting on whether or not to have the OHSBCA endorse this program.
- VI. **Minutes from Executive Meeting – July 25, 2008 at Columbus, Ohio**
  - A. Clinic Fee change – Pre-registered cost from \$55.00 to \$70.00 and at the door to \$85.00 dollars
  - B. State Association Dues increase for 2009-10 – Dues will be increased to \$20.00 per member
  - C. Corporate Sponsorship Outline – **Wally Vickers** is creating an outline for sponsorship to the OHSBCA. Anyone with ideas should submit them to him.
  - D. Foundation Game Review – Kim Mahoney (OHSAA) will speak briefly at the clinic. We will ask Dr. Ross what % of teams need to play a foundation game for us to be given a games increase to our schedule.
  - E. Girls Top 100 Showcase – **Dave Butcher** reported that it can be held April 18, 2009 at Otterbein College. We decided to proceed with preparations.
  - F. Player of the Year Changes – **President Froelich** stated that we wanted to make a constitutional change that the POY would

NOT have to play in the N/S Games, if they were playing in two nationally sponsored games approved by the HOF committee.  
**1<sup>st</sup> – Bob Walsh 2<sup>nd</sup> – Bob Miller** to make this change. We will need another reading at the next meeting.

- G. District Nomination for NFHS COY – each district should submit a name to the executive committee for selection.
- H. Fundamentals of Coaching Class- this requirement was reviewed. You will need to complete the class by Aug. 1, 2010 and it is available on-line for \$35.00 before Nov. 1, 2008, but we will increase after that date. Go to NFHSlearn.com for information, or to the OHSAA website.
- I. HOF Banquet changes – The social Hour will now start at 5:30pm, and there will be NO presenters for each inductee. We also will limit the size of each class to four people. Banquet will be April 18, 2009.
- J. Jerry Snodgrass, OHSAA Asst. Commissioner – It appears that we will be having a mandatory dead period for ALL sports in the summer. It will center around the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday. We may get an individual workout period two weeks prior to our season if this change occurs.
- K. **Larry Wilson** – Public Relations Report - 1) Larry explained Ohio National Guard presentation of plaques, and their future plans 2) Discussion about violations? Do we need to inform the membership? 3) Gatorade sponsorship? He has not heard from them about the Top 100, also stated that Rawlings has been excellent in what they have provided us 4) Asked who was doing FG/FT/3PT awards for this year? 5) He would like each district to have a website, and to put names of coaching changes on the site, or at least send him the names of coaching changes 6) Stated the cost of State Tournament Rooms increased to \$153.00 per night. 4 night stay is required 7) Past President's Breakfast – It will be March 28, 2009 at 8:30am at the Holiday Inn on Lane. The breakfast will be held every other year in conjunction with the changing of presidents. 8) *Hooplines* Expense Report – Larry handed out information about the cost of each issue. He will limit the number of pages in some issues. 9) Each district director needs to list the schools in his district so we are aware of changes. We need a master list of schools in each district. 10) He expressed concern over century award winners only joining on the year or near the years they will be receiving an honor. How do we handle this?
