### MINUTES

- I. **Welcome - President Wally Vickers** welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- II. **Prayer – Bob Von Kaenel** led us in prayer.
- III. **Roll Call – Bob Von Kaenel** called roll. Absent were – Rich Venuto and Pat Carroll, Dean Clark.
- IV. **Treasurer’s Report – Wayne Wiseman** – Was Accepted – **1<sup>st</sup> – Tom McBride, 2<sup>nd</sup>- Dan Schwieterman.** Wayne also stated that the memberships were being received and that he already had 768 members registered for this year. He reminded coaches that the deadline is December 31, 2009.
- V. **Minutes from Executive Meeting – July 17, 2009 at Cincinnati, Ohio**
  - A. Program Ad for N/S Game – Increased to \$125.00 per player.
  - B. Fast Draw Software was endorsed by OHSBCA. It would be available for only \$25.00 dollars.
  - C. Each District should have a Website in place by October.
  - D. Foundation Game Review – President Vickers encouraged everyone to continue to support the OHSAA Foundation Game.
  - E. Fundamentals of Coaching Class- this requirement was reviewed. You will need to complete the class by Jan. 1, 2010 and it is available on-line. Coaches were reminded to tell their staffs and districts.

- VI. **Public Relations Report – Larry Wilson - 1)** Reminded OHSBCA that the *Rawlings* contract expires on July 31, 2010. **2)** He will continue to put the Scholarship Society form in *Hooplines* **3)** He announced a special room rate at the Columbus Airport Marriott for the HOF Banquet April 17, 2010. **4)** He reminded all district directors that he needs a list of member schools from their district. This will help in all areas of activities done by the OHSBCA **5)** The constitutional process of selecting an alternate director was re-visited. Everyone was reminded that your 2<sup>nd</sup> highest vote-getter would be your district’s alternate if someone cannot complete

their term of office **6) State Tournament Rooms** – He explained that rooms will be at Holiday Inn Express on Olentangy River Road. Cost of rooms (\$129.00 per night) was announced, and the reservation policies and deadlines were explained. **7) He reminded everyone that the OHSAA approved video replay for the State Tournament.**
